# Viking Subscriber Software 18.2 Point Release: Feb 2019

This Field Software Notice (FSN) announces the KENWOOD Viking® subscriber software version 18.2 point release. This release provides new features and bug fixes for Viking radios. This release supersedes KENWOOD Viking software release 18.2 release.

## **Features Added**

Following new features are added in the 18.2 point release.

Feature Description	Overview
VM7000 VHF Hi-Power (110W) Release	A high power version of the VHF VM7000 is introduced in the 18.2 point release.
Repeater On/Off Switch Function for VM 1000 series DB25 connector	Adds the ability to remotely turn the repeater on and off by assigning a Repeater On/Off Switch function to an input pin on the DB25 connector of the Viking 1000 series mobile radio.
Pause Scan when Vehicular Repeater Enabled	Adds the ability to program the Viking Mobile to pause scan when the Vehicular repeater is enabled. Previous versions of radio software would pause scan when EVRS is enabled. Some customers do not want scan to be paused. This allows the pause scan feature to be turned off or enabled without EVRS being enabled.
Disable Ignition Sense when Vehicular Repeater Enabled	Adds the ability to disable the ignition sense settings when the vehicular repeater in enabled. This allows the user to turn off the ignition and leave the car without having the vehicular repeater power down.
Bluetooth Remote Volume Control	VPx000 and VMx000 radios now support AT commands for remote volume control.
Bluetooth Receive Audio Routing	VPx000 and VMx000 radios now support routing audio to either a connected Bluetooth headset, or the radio speaker.
Only Allow Bluetooth Auto-connect to Last Device	Bluetooth will try to connect to devices that it is already paired to. This Armada check only allows the radio to auto-connect to the Bluetooth device most recently connected to.

## **Feature Enhancements**

GE Star IDs	Allow GE Star IDs: ANI, ENI and all NYSP parameters (Zone, Troop and
	Unit) to be programmed on codeplugs, even when linked to
